Class Registration and Policies

To sign up for a class, stop by or call the shop (513-895-5648). We ask that you put down 1/2 the class fee as a deposit. When signing up for a class, please purchase the materials at the store. All materials that are for the class will be at a 10% discount. 10% discount applies to a one-time purchase only. (Knit-a-long materials are not discounted.) Books and accessories for the classes are non-refundable.

Help Policy

We are always happy to assist a fellow knitter with any problems, but sometimes we are busy. If we can help you in 15 minutes or less, the help is no charge. If it's going to take longer, we ask that you schedule an appointment with a store employee. This is to better serve you, the customer. With an appointment, you will receive our undivided attention. The cost for help is \$10 per hour. This is very reasonable considering the years of experience we have. Anyone signing up for a class will receive 60 minutes of free help on the class project. Please call ahead if you would like help with your class project. If you have any questions about the policy, please don't hesitate to ask.

Beginning Knitting for Adults

Session 1: Sat, Oct. 12 10-12

Cost: \$10

Materials: Smooth worsted weight light colored yarn, size 8 needles

Description: Come on in and learn to knit! You will learn the basics of knitting while getting the knowledge that you will need to do projects of your choice. During the class you'll learn the basics, casting on, knitting, purling and binding off.

Beginning Crochet is offered by appointment.

Monday Night Knit & Crochet Too

When: Mondays 6 - 8 pm

Cost: Free

Description: Come and hang out with fellow knitters and crocheters, share your knowledge and projects. As a courtesy to the shop, we appreciate that on Knit Night, you knit or crochet with Lambikin's yarn. Knit & Crochet night is for adults only.

Finishing Class

Finishing classes are available by appointment. Bring in a project to finish and we will help you with picking up stitches, adding button bands, seaming and blocking. Cost is \$10 per hour.

The Friends' Class

This a private class for you and your friends to work on a specific project that isn't on our current class schedule. Call the shop to schedule this private party. The cost for this 2 hour class is \$20 per person.

Socks 101 - Double points or 9" circular

When: Saturday, Oct 5, 19 & Nov 2 1-3 pm

Cost: \$10

Materials: suggested DK sock yarn, appropriate sized needles.

Description: Socks are the perfect small project! Knit them in the car, by the fire, or at a game. Wherever your travels take you, socks are fun and portable!!

Socks 201 - Magic Loop

When: By appointment

Cost: \$10

Materials: yarn, appropriate sized 32" - 40" circular needle

Description: Don't like all those pointy needles? Do the tiny circular ones make you crazy? Come in and have us show you another sock knitting method.

Nightshift Shawl by Andrea Mowry

When: Saturday, October 12 & 26
1-3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Leslie

Materials: two skeins Noro Ito

Description: This super fun shawl has a large canvas for color play! This pattern includes a recipe, to make it all your own, or row by row directions for those who want to play it safe!

Beginning Sweater - Staring at the Stars by Alicia Plummer

When: Sunday, October 13, 27, November 10, 24 & December 8
3-5 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Materials: Worsted/Heavy DK, appropriate needles for gauge

Description: This is the perfect first sweater. It's a top-down, seamless, raglan with a fun detail around the bottom. You'll be knitting your first sweater in no time. Now's the time. Just do it!!!

Classes

Malibu Shawl by Jodie Brown

When: Monday, October 14 & 28
6—8 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Nora

Materials: three skeins DK in contrasting colors

Description: For her first shawl pattern Jodie wanted to combine all the things she loves about her favorite shawls: asymmetrical shape, stripes (a must because the contrast of color adds a “pop” to any project), dropped stitches (her favorite for shawls) and of course fringe...because what's not to love about fringe? When choosing your colors think about how they are going to contrast each other.

Briocherry Hat by Katrin Schubert

When: Saturday, October 19 & November 16
10 am - 12 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Materials: two contrasting colors of DK weight yarn

Description: The pattern has only six repeating pattern rows and is based on basic brioche stitches, increases and decreases. It's important to note that there is no 4-stitch-decrease to be knit. You can do it, knitters! The hat can be knit in multiple sizes only by changing needle size and gauge; Block the finished cap over a steep-sided bowl or other head-shaped form to smooth the crown.

Haverhill Shawl by Mindy Wilkes

When: Saturday, October 26 & November 9
10 - 12 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Mindy

Materials: 375 yards each of two different fingering weight yarns in contrasting yarn

Description: Haverhill is a two-color, top-down, triangular shawl. The upper body of the shawl is garter stitch and the lower body includes lace and bobbles. You can not work the bobbles if you choose. The lace pattern is charted, and the pattern includes written, row by row instructions for the chart. All special stitches are explained in the pattern. A second PDF is included with row by row stitch counts.

Crux Hat by Carina Spencer

When: Saturday, November 16 & 30
1 - 3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Materials: two contrasting colors of yarn in either fingering or worsted

Description: A reversible hat in a timeless style, worked in a two-color, slipped stitch pattern. Pattern is written for two gauges to accommodate sock or worsted weight yarns, and includes four sizes to fit all ages, with directions for beanie and slouch styles.

Storm Shawl by Joji Locatelli

When: Saturday, December 14 & 28
1 - 3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Materials: 430 yards of fingering weight yarn

Description: Storm uses just one skein of precious fingering weight yarn. It features dramatic dropped stitches and short rows that give this pattern a de-constructed look while also giving you a bigger shawl with the same yardage.

Knit-A-Long - Canyon Road by Casapinka

When: Sunday, Oct. 6, 20, Nov. 3, 17 & Dec. 1
1-3 pm

Cost: FREE

Who: Nora

Materials: three contrasting colors of fingering weight yarn

Description: Canyon Road features two pretty lace panels separated by areas of stranded knitting for a unique yoke with scalloped accents. This is a fairly fast sweater to knit, with subtle side seams and a casual fit.

Goldfish Memory Shawl by Casapinka

When: Sunday, October 13, 27, November 10, 24 & December 8 1-3 pm

Cost: FREE

Who: Cathy

Materials: 400 yards of three contrasting fingering weight yarns

Description: This is a parallelogram and is knit on the bias. You need 3 skeins of fingering weight yarn, 400 yards each. We advise a very light skein, a bright or bolder skein, and something in between. If the colors are too similar the slipped stitches won't show up.
