Class Registration and Policies

To sign up for a class, stop by or call the shop (513-895-5648). We ask that you put down 1/2 the class fee as a deposit. When signing up for a class, please purchase the materials at the store. All materials that are for the class will be at a 10% discount. 10% discount applies to a one-time purchase only. (Knit-a-long materials are not discounted.) Books and accessories for the classes are non-refundable.

Help Policy

We are always happy to assist a fellow knitter with any problems, but sometimes we are busy. If we can help you in 15 minutes or less, the help is no charge. If it's going to take longer, we ask that you schedule an appointment with a store employee. This is to better serve you, the customer. With an appointment, you will receive our undivided attention. The cost for help is \$10 hour. This is very reasonable considering the years of experience we have. Anyone signing up for a class will receive 60 minutes of free help on the class project. Materials: Smooth worsted weight light colored yarn, size 8 needles

Description: Come on in and learn to knit! You will learn the basics of knitting while getting the knowledge that you will need to do projects of your choice. During the class you'll learn the basics, casting on, knitting, purling and binding off.

Monday Night Knit & Crochet Too

Socks 101 - Double points or 9" circular

When: Saturday, Feb. 18, Mar. 4 and 18 10 am - 12 pm

Materials: DK or worsted weight sock yarn, appropriate sized needles.

Description: Socks are the perfect fall project! Knit them in the car or at a game.

Materials: yarn, appropriate sized 32" - 40" circular needle

Description: Don't like all those pointy needles? Do the tiny circular ones make you crazy? Come in and have us show you another sock knitting method.

Beginning Crochet

Materials: smooth, light colored, worsted weight yarn, size H hook

Description: Crochet is making a huge comeback! It's not just granny squares any more. Join Michelle for this beginner class and learn the basics of chain, single, double, and half double crochet, plus many more stitches.

Gramps Cardigan by tincanknits

When: Sunday, Jan. 29, Feb. 12, 26, Mar. 12, 26, Apr. 9 & 23 3 - 5 pm

Cost: \$10

Materials: worsted weight, US 6 & 7

Description: Gramps Cardigan is available in sizes newborn - 4XL. A perfect first sweater. Gramps is knit from the top down for seamless construction. Button bands are picked up at the end and can be done in a contrasting color. Pockets are optional.

Corrugated Curves Shawl by 10 Hours or Less

When: Monday, January 30, Feb. 13 & 27 6 - 8 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Chris

Materials: 360 yards DK, US 9 needle

Description: Wrap yourself in everyday elegance with a woolly woven-look shawl! Knitted with just one color at-a-time, this piece boasts bi-color Corrugated Rib bordered by striped Garter chevrons. Best of all? It's worked from corner-to-corner in a simple 4-row repeat, so you can just keep knitting until the yarn runs out.

Gauley Socks by Mindy Wilkes

When: Saturday, Feb. 11 & 25 10 am - 12 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Mindy

Materials: fingering weight yarn, US 1 needles

Description: Inspired by the zig zagging rapids of the Gauley River in West Virginia, the socks have a zig zag stranded colorwork pattern on the leg and at the toe. Contrast heels and toes add a bright pop of color, making the Gauley Socks a fun and sporty pair of socks.

Fixing Mistakes

Description: Are you plagued by dropped stitches? Do you have trouble reading your knitting? If you don't know what to do when you make a mistake, join us for this two hour class and become a more independent knitter!

The Easy Ombre Slouch Hat by Pearl S Neary

When: Sunday, Feb. 19, Mar. 5 & 19 3 - 5 pm

Cost: \$10

Materials: 218 yards DK weight yarn, US 6 needles

Description: This quick and easy hat is a fabulous way to learn stranded knitting! Choose two distinct colors to create a dramatic ombre effect or two similar shades for a graduated blended effect.

Tinsel Mitts by Andrea Mowry

When: Monday, February 20 & March 6 6 - 8 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Michelle

Materials: 100 - 240 yards DK weight yarn, US 5 & 6 needles

Description: Everyone needs a good pair of mittens - whether they be the classic, the convertible, or the fingerless - this pattern has got you - and the whole family - covered! A simple relaxing knit, with faux seams up the front and back to add a touch of modern style. Easily knit up in a night or a weekend & using less than a skein of yarn, these mitts are the perfect fall & winter pattern!

Guyandotte Cowl by Mindy Wilkes

When: Saturday, March 4, 18 & April 1 1 - 3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Mindy

Materials: 500 yards sport weight yarn, US 4 needle

Description: Guyandotte Cowl is worked entirely in the round beginning with a provisional cast on. The pattern features one round stripes and stranded colorwork. You can wear the cowl long or looped twice around your neck for extra warmth.

Chunky 2-Color Brioche Cowl by Cathy Gallagher

When: Saturday, March 11 & 25 1 - 3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Materials: two skeins of contrasting colors of chunky weight yarn, US 13

Description: Brioche is everywhere in the knitting world right now, and if your New Year's resolution was to learn how to do this, this is the class for you. With two skeins of chunky yarn and size 13 needles you'll have a completed project in no time. **Homework required: casting on and knitting 3 rounds with your main color.**

Ruxton Shawl by Dee O'Keefe

When: Saturday, March 11 & 25 10 am - 12 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Michelle

Materials: 630 - 680 Yards sport weight yarn, US 5 & 6 needle

Description: Ruxton is a super-textured, warm and snuggly, top-down triangular lace shawl with motifs inspired by nature. The decrease placement in the richly textured border pattern and the picot bind off combine to form a subtle ruffling effect at the bottom, giving the shawl a lovely drape. The shape is a slightly elongated triangle, and may be blocked with the top edge straight or a bit curved.

Coastal Walk Shawl by Joji Locatelli

When: Sunday, April 2, 16 & 30 3 - 5 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Nora

Materials: 500 yards DK/Sport weight yarn, US 7
Description: This is an asymmetrical shawl with a lace body and an irregular garter stitch border. Worked in DK weight yarn, this project will grow so fast you won't even believe it's done already.

Broken Wings Shawl by Joji Lacatelli

Session: Saturday, April 8 & 22 1 - 3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Description: This Joji pattern is a beautiful asymmetric shawl from one skein of fingering weight yarn. This is great project if you want to learn to work from charts, and there are written directions, too.

Knit-A-Long - Lady Sunnyside by Tanis Lavallee

When: Sunday, January 29, February 19, March 5, 19, April 2 and 16 1 - 3 pm

Cost: FREE

Who: Cathy

Description: This cardigan is worked from the top down in one piece. The collar band is knit first from a provisional cast on, stitches are then picked up along the bottom of the collar and the sweater is worked flat from there with the collar band transitioning into the button band for a completely seamless sweater.

Knit-A-Long - Analeigh by Irina Anikeeva

When: Sunday, February 12, 26, March 12, 26, April 9 & 23

Cost: FREE

Who: Nora

Description: Analeigh cardigan is worked in one piece from top to bottom. The torso is shaped gently at the waist. Stitches for stockinette sleeves are picked up along armholes and caps are worked using a German short-row technique. The cardigan is embellished front and back with a lace/cable pattern, which can be worked either from charts or from written descriptions.
