To sign up for a class, stop by or call the shop (513-895-5648). We ask that you put down 1/2 the class fee as a deposit. When signing up for a class, please purchase the materials at the store. All materials that are for the class will be at a 10% discount. 10% discount applies to a one-time purchase only. (Knit-a-long materials are not discounted.) Books and accessories for the classes are non-refundable.

Help Policy

We are always happy to assist a fellow knitter with any problems, but sometimes we are busy. If we can help you in 15 minutes or less, the help is no charge. If it's going to take longer, we ask that you schedule an appointment with a store employee. This is to better serve you, the customer. With an appointment, you will receive our undivided attention. The cost for help is \$10 hour. This is very reasonable considering the years of experience we have. Anyone signing up for a class will receive 60 minutes of free help on the class project. Description: A stitch sampler cowl made of five different stitch patterns. Perfect for a mini skein pack. You choose a short or long version.

Pumpkin Socks by Sabine Ruppert

When: Sunday, Oct. 8, 22 & Nov. 5 3 - 5 pm

Materials: 350-400 yards fingering weight yarn, US 2 needles

Description: Adorable socks with pumpkins made using little cables.

The Magic Hour by Mindy Wilkes

When: Saturday, October 14 & November 4

1 - 3 pm

Who: Mindy

Materials: 400 yards of fingering weight yarn, US 5 needles

Description: The Magic Hour is an asymmetrical, triangular shawl with garter stitch and lace. Increases are worked along one edge to create the shape. The shawl is finished with an eyelet picot edge. The Magic Hour requires only one skein of fingering weight yarn.

Aviat by Corrina Ferguson

When: Saturday, October 14 & 28 10 - 12 pm

Cost: \$10

Materials: DK weight yarn, US 6 or 7 needles

Description: This cowl-kerchief is a delight with twisted stitches, extra length at the front for tucking into your jacket, and a lofty, soft drape. It knits up quick-as-a-wink for your early autumn accessory needs. The cowlette starts with a flat triangle, and is then joined and worked in the round to form the cowl neck..

Hat #5 by Kara McKinley

When: Saturday, Oct. 28 & Nov. 11 1 - 3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Leslie

Materials: 100 - 150 yards worsted weight yarn, US 8 needle

Description: Hat No. 5 is knit in the round and uses basic cabling. This is a great project for an adventurous beginner ready to take on a cabled hat or an experienced knitter looking for an easy to remember, quick cabled hat pattern

Arrow Cowl by Lisa Hannes

When: Sat., Nov. 4, 18 & Dec. 2 10 -12 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Materials: two colors of fingering weight yarn, appropriate needle

Description: This cowl features a mix of different stitch patterns and textures worked in two contrasting colors. A mosaic motif in the

center creates an eye-catching arrow. Mosaic knitting is an easy to work colorwork technique that uses slipped stitches and only one color at a time. Choose your two favorite colors with good contrast to make this cowl, which is fun to knit and easy to wear. The pattern provides fully written out instructions as well as charts.

Ceridwin Shawl by Alison Green

When: Monday, Nov. 6, 20 & Dec. 4 6 - 8 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Chris

Materials: 490 yards of DK weight yarn, US 7 needles

Description: An architectural lace pattern is knit lengthwise, then stitches are then picked up along the side of the border. Short rows are worked in garter stitch to form the body of this crescent-shaped shawl.

Wear a Hug Shawl by Kristina Vilimaite

Session: Sunday, Nov. 12 & 26 3 - 5 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Materials: two colors of fingering weight yarn

Description: Knitting starts with just a few stitches, and smartly placed increases and decreases give the shawl the asymmetric curved triangle shape. The shawl is worked sideways in one piece. The second color is used without breaking yarn. The size of the shawl can be easily customized as it can be bound off on every eighth row.

Leaves of the Lake by Casapinka

When: Sunday, November 19 & December 3

3 - 5 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Nora

Materials: 370 yards fingering weight yarn

Description: Leaves of the Lake is a boomerang shawl with simple textured stitches. Use your favorite tonal color to create your own Leaves of the Lake. There are knits and purls, a few slipped stitches for texture and a yarn over here and there. There is a chart for the purled leaves panel as well as written instructions.

Which Way Shawl by Stephanie Shiman

When: Saturday, Nov. 18 & Dec. 2 1 - 3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Description: You'll get somewhere quick with this chevron stripe shawl made with one main color and five mini skeins. Attractive, slim stripes allow you to carry your colors along, so you'll only weave in ends where you've moved on to the next mini skein.

Knit-A-Long - Avix by Jennifer Dassau

When: Sunday, Oct. 1, 15, 29, Nov. 12, 26 & Dec. 3
1 - 3 pm

Cost: FREE

Who: Cathy

Description: Avix is worked seamlessly from the top down in stockinette with expanding lace panels flanked by arrowhead mesh and eyelet columns. Stitches are picked up around the armholes, the sleeve caps are shaped with short rows, then worked seamlessly in stockinette to the forearm where an eyelet pattern extends to the cuffs.

Knit-A-Long - Let Go by Joji Locatelli

When: Sunday, Oct. 8, 22, Nov. 5, 19 & Dec. 3
1 - 3 pm

Cost: FREE

Who: Nora

Description: Let Go is worked seamlessly from the top down. It has comfortable shoulder lines, fun cables and a flattering subtle A-line in the body. No need to close it in the front, since this design is meant to be worn open. So come on, let go of any fears and feel free knitting away this lovely design.
