## Class Registration and Policies

To sign up for a class, stop by or call the shop (513-895-5648). We ask that you put down 1/2 the class fee as a deposit. When signing up for a class, please purchase the materials at the store. All materials that are for the class will be at a 10% discount. 10% discount applies to a one-time purchase only. (Knit-a-long materials are not discounted.) Books and accessories for the classes are non-refundable.

## Help Policy

We are always happy to assist a fellow knitter with any problems, but sometimes we are busy. If we can help you in 15 minutes or less, the help is no charge. If it's going to take longer, we ask that you schedule an appointment with a store employee. This is to better serve you, the customer. With an appointment, you will receive our undivided attention. The cost for help is \$20 per hour. This is very reasonable considering the years of experience we have. Anyone signing up for a class will receive 60 minutes of free help on the class project. Please call ahead if you would like help with your class project. If you have any questions about the policy, please don't hesitate to ask.

### Beginning Knitting for Adults

**Session 1:** Mon. 10/23 1-3 pm

**Cost:** \$20

**Materials:** Smooth worsted weight light colored yarn, size 8 needles

**Description:** Come on in and learn to knit! You will learn the basics of knitting while getting the knowledge that you will need to do projects of your choice. During the class you'll learn the basics, casting on, knitting, purling and binding off.

**Beginning crochet is offered by appointment.**

### Monday Night Knit & Crochet Too

**When:** Mondays 6 - 8 pm

**Cost:** Free

**Description:** Come and hang out with fellow yarn enthusiasts, share your knowledge and projects. As a courtesy to the shop, we appreciate that you knit or crochet with Lambikin's yarn. Knit & Crochet night is for adults only.

### Finishing Class

Finishing classes are available by appointment. Bring in a project to finish and we will help you with picking up stitches, adding button bands, seaming and blocking. Cost is \$20 per hour.

This a private class for you and your friends to work on a specific project that isn't on our current class schedule. Call the shop to schedule this private party. The cost for this 2 hour class is \$40 per person.

**Materials:** suggested DK sock yarn, appropriate sized needles.

**Description:** Socks are the perfect small project! Knit them in the car, by the fire, or at a game. Wherever your travels take you, socks are fun and portable!!

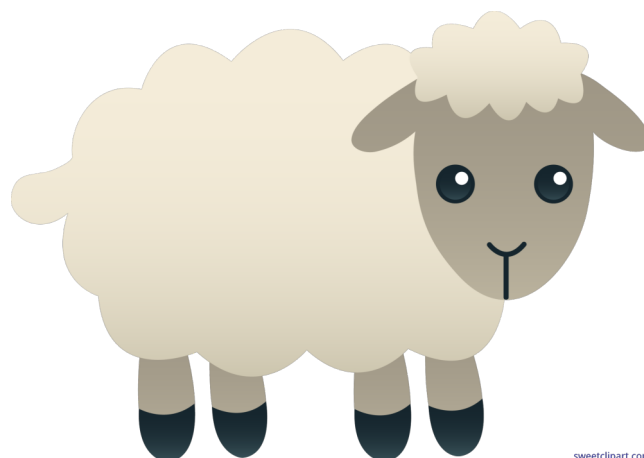
### Socks 201 - Magic Loop or Two at a Time

**When:** By appointment

**Cost:** \$20

**Materials:** yarn, appropriate sized 32" - 40" circular needle

**Description:** Don't like all those pointy needles? Do the tiny circular ones make you crazy? Come in and have us show you another sock knitting method.



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## Classes

### Swish Scarf by Tanis Lavallee

**When:** Saturday, October 21, November 4, 18, & December 2 1-3 pm

**Cost:** \$20

**Who:** Cathy

**Materials:** 520 yards, 100 g of DK weight yarn in each of 2 coordinating colors, US6 needle

**Description:** A fun, first brioche project. This pattern is a great introduction to 2 color brioche. You will master increases as well as right and left leaning decreases and will be ready to tackle something more ambitious on your next brioche adventure.

### Beginning Sweater - First Raglan Sweater by Jared Flood

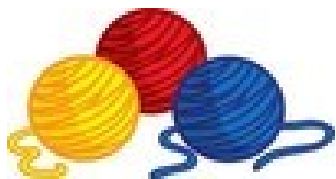
**When:** Sunday, November 5, 19, December 3, 17, & January 14 3-5 pm

**Cost:** \$20

**Who:** Cathy

**Materials:** Worsted weight yarn and appropriate needles for gauge

**Description:** This approachable sweater is worked in the round, with no seams or assembly required. And even better, its top-down construction means you can try it on as you go to ensure it fits just right. The downloadable companion offers even more options to enrich your sweater shape, like a slimmer sleeve and body shaping to suit your preferred style. Mix and match design elements and find your stride in sweater knitting.



### KAL A - Arco Iris by Joji Locitelli

**When:** Sunday, October 29, November 12, 26, December 10, & January 7 1-3

**Cost:** FREE

**Who:** Regina

**Materials:** DK weight yarn, appropriate needle for gauge

**Description:** A V-neck pullover with an interesting ribbing design.

### KAL B - Ranunculus by Midori Hirose

**When:** Sunday, October 22, November 5, 19, December 3, 17, & January 14 1-3 pm

**Cost:** FREE

**Who:** Cathy

**Materials:** For the most part, you can pick any yarn. We'll help you figure out the amount and needle size.

**Description:** Ranunculus is one of the most popular patterns on Ravelry with over 20,000 projects. Have you knit yours yet? If not, come and join the fun. You can use most any yarn at most any gauge—we'll show you how. Please note the pattern as written is for a cropped sweater at a gauge of 13 stitches/4". If you choose to knit it at a different gauge (Cathy's is 17st/4") or add length you will use more yarn than recommended in the pattern.
