To sign up for a class, stop by or call the shop (513-895-5648). We ask that you put down 1/2 the class fee as a deposit. When signing up for a class, please purchase the materials at the store. All materials that are for the class will be at a 10% discount. 10% discount applies to a one-time purchase only. (Knit-a-long materials are not discounted.) Books and accessories for the classes are non-refundable.

Help Policy

We are always happy to assist a fellow knitter with any problems, but sometimes we are busy. If we can help you in 15 minutes or less, the help is no charge. If it's going to take longer, we ask that you schedule an appointment with a store employee. This is to better serve you, the customer. With an appointment, you will receive our undivided attention. The cost for help is \$10 hour. This is very reasonable considering the years of experience we have. Anyone signing up for a class will receive 60 minutes of free help on the class project. Materials: Smooth worsted weight light colored yarn, size 8 needles

Description: Come on in and learn to knit! You will learn the basics of knitting while getting the knowledge that you will need to do projects of your choice. During the class you'll learn the basics, casting on, knitting, purling and binding off.

Monday Night Knit & Crochet Too

When: Mondays 6 - 8 pm

Cost: Free

Cancun Boxy Lace Top by Erin Kate Archer

When: Saturday, June 3, 17 & July 1
1 - 3 pm

Materials: 500 yards DK, US 8 needle

Description: This lace sampler top is knit in two simple rectangles from the bottom up & seamed at the shoulders and sides to create the boxy shape. Very suitable for beginners, would make an excellent first garment!

Kindness Shawl by Jaala Spiro

When: Monday, June 5, 19 & July 10
6 - 8 pm

Cost: \$10

Materials: 430 yards fingering weight yarn, US 6 needles

Description: Mesh, lace and a soothing color make the Kindness shawl a lovely project to keep or give to a loved one. Intuitive increase construction and understandable lace patterns make it less difficult than it may first appear!

Monochrome Cowl by Joji Locatelli

When: Sunday, June 18 & July 2
3 - 5 pm

Cost: \$10

Materials: fingering weight yarn

Description: At first sight, it might look like a simple cowl with some easy eyelets. But there's much more to it. This versatile cowl explores some easy and beautiful lace patterns. It is the perfect project to get familiar with lace and some of its variations. Choose a soft and luxurious yarn to make a piece that you will always want to keep on your neck.

Passing Showers by Elizabeth Smith

When: Saturday, June 24, July 8, 22 & August 5

Materials: DK weight yarn, appropriate needles for gauge

Description: Passing Showers is an open-style short sleeved cardigan using DK weight or light worsted weight yarn. It is knit in one piece from the top-down and features A-line body shaping. An eyelet stitch pattern is featured on the back as well as along the bottom hem. Stitches are picked up to create the front bands. An easy layering piece, perfect for warmer weather!

Shaelyn Shawl by Leila Raabe

10 am - 12 pm

Materials: fingering or sport weight yarn, appropriate needle

Description: A top down center out triangular shawl with alternating sections of lace and stockinette. Lace is both charted and written.

Mercury Socks by Kim Drotar

3 - 5 pm

Materials: fingering weight yarn, appropriate needle

Description: This is a simple lace sock knit cuff down with a gusset heel. There are four size options so everybody should be able to find the right fit!

Oscillare Cowl by Barbara Benson

When: Monday, July 24 & August 7
6 - 8 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Chris

Materials: 200 yards of two different colors of DK weight yarn, US 4 & 6 needles

Description: A simple mosaic-knit cowl. It's knit using only one strand of yarn at a time. You are knitting stripes and slipping stitches. It is probably the easiest colorwork, other than just knitting stripes. The pattern is fully written out and with charts for those who like them.

Constellate Hat by Hunter Hammersen

Session: Saturday, August 19 & September 2
1 - 3 pm

Cost: \$10

Who: Cathy

Materials: fingering weight yarn

Description: Sometimes simple and classic is the way to go. And it doesn't get much more simple or classic than a lovely ribbed hat. But charming though the classics may be, how about a little something extra to keep it interesting? And the beautiful stitch on this hat is just the thing!

Baker's Hat by Susan B. Anderson

When: Sunday, August 20 & September 10
3 - 5 pm

Cost: \$10

Materials: 370 yards fingering weight yarn

Description: A great basic beanie knit using a ribbing and stockinette pattern.

Knit-A-Long - Sugarcane Cardigan by Carol Feller

When: Sunday, May 14, 28, June 11, 25, July 9, 23 & August 6 1 - 3 pm

Cost: FREE

Who: Nora

Description: The soft draped collar, gentle undulating lace and flattering raglan shoulder shaping make this cardigan a great staple. It can be worn as an everyday about town cardigan or as a finishing touch for over that spring dress. Pick how you want to finish this cardigan; 3/4 or long sleeves? Shawl collar or open front? You'll find lots of options!

Knit-A-Long - Sea Salt Cardigan by Laura Aylor

When: Sunday, June 4, 18, July 2, 16 & 30 1 - 3 pm

Cost: FREE

Description: A comfy casual pullover knit in DK weight yarn. Starting with one split garter sleeve cuff and knitting across the bodice to the other, the body is then picked up and knit in stockinette in the round, finishing up with a split garter hem. This pullover is designed to be worn with at least an inch or two of positive ease. Choose your size accordingly.
