Knit-A-Long - Throwback Thursday by Mary Annarella When: Sunday, Feb. 3, 17,

Description: This sweater pattern is available in both fingering and worsted weight. It's totally up to you which pattern you buy. Throwback Thursday features a rolled neck but is updated with a split hem, an easy lace + cable design at the sides, and a set-in sleeve that is worked simultaneously with the upper bodice.

Knit-A-Long - Chevron Flight by Laura Reinbach

When: Sunday, Feb. 10, Mar. 3, 10, 24, Apr. 14, & 28

Materials: Two colors of worsted weight yarn and appropriate

needles for gauge

Description: This sweater is worked from the bottom up in the round. First the body is worked straight to the underarms. Next, two sleeves are made, then knitted on to the body. Short rows are worked to start shaping the back of the yoke. Once the colorwork and yoke shaping are complete, the last few short rows are worked to raise the back of the neck.
