**Description:** Speckles is constructed from the top down with raglan shaping. You will knit it inside-out so you won't be purling an entire sweater. There are subtle slip stitches on the side and a textured rib along the bottom and 4" of the same rib along the sleeves. A good first sweater and great for social knitting.

Flying Bird Shortie Socks by Joji Locatelli

Materials: 230 - 280 yards of a fingering weight yarn & US1 needle

Description: Little shortie socks. Simple, cute and fast to make, because when all your friends see yours, they'll want a pair too! They are worked from the top down and they feature a gorgeous ribbed textured pattern on the top of the foot. They have a ribbed heel flap and a wide toe.

Circle of Friends Shawl by Joji Locatelli

August 14 1 - 3 pm

Materials: two contrasting colors of yarn in fingering weight, US 6 circular

needle

**Description:** Circle of Friends is a large 2 color crescent shaped shawl. It features garter stitch and cute little bobbles. FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Approx. 70 inches (175cm) from side to side and 16 inches (40 cm) from top to bottom at deepest point (after blocking).

KAL A – The Birdwatcher by Casapinka

August 8, & 22 1-3 pm

Materials: Fingering/DK weight yarn,

appropriate needle for gauge

Description: The Birdwatcher is a slightly cropped summer top that looks great in a speckled or tonal yarn. It is constructed in the round from the bottom, up to the underarms (just knit more rounds to un-crop it.) You then knit back and forth separately, and join the shoulders with a three needle bind off (video link in pattern). It is not difficult!

KAL B - Bonnie by Amy Christoffers When: Sunday, June 20, July 11, 25,

August 15, & 29 1-3 pm



Materials: Bonnie is designed for Berroco Chai, but any DK yarn will work,

appropriate needle for gauge

**Description:** Stunning lace gives this top endless elegance while also making it perfect for everyday wear. Stitch pattern has both charted and written instructions.
